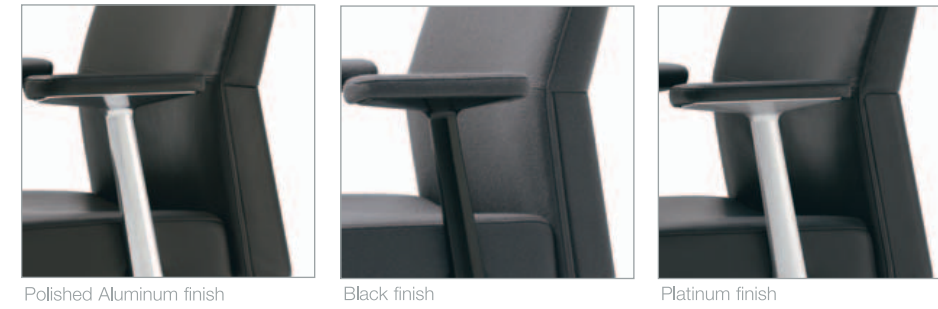




Improving every step, from factory to recycle bin.

To understand the environmental impact of every stage in the Siento™ chair's life cycle, the University of Michigan conducted a full Life Cycle Assessment (LCA) of the chair. Additionally, McDonough Braungart Design Chemistry (MBDC) analyzed every material in the Siento chair to ensure safety to both human and environmental health. Siento is made of up to 28% recycled content and is up to 91% recyclable, in large part because it's 100% chrome- and PVC-free. Plus, the leather used is 100% chromium-free. Altogether making it a great candidate for the Steelcase Environmental Partnership program, which can help you eventually resell, donate, or recycle your Siento chair. Not, of course, that you would ever dream of parting with it.

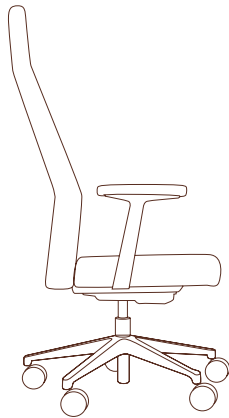
